New Business

- Move up
 - The NCA in helping support local associations and keeping a level playing field within the trial community will recognize and support all local organizations and their rules of moving handlers from the Novice and the Intermediate class.
 - Rules include the dog of year points for first and second and also placement in the local association's finals of champion and reserve.
 - As always, local associations and hosts have the final say of who will run in each class, but the NCA will follow and implement these movements accordingly.
 - Discussion occurred. It was decided to table the discussion.
- Nursery Rules Discussion
 - The old Nursery will be implemented whereas:
 - if a Nursery age dog scores points in the Open class that dog is automatically eligible for National Finals
 - and will also receive Nursery points for those points scored in Open class.
 - In addition, Intermediates that wish to run in Nursery class and upon scoring points will also be awarded Intermediate points for scoring in the Nursery class.
 - Any Intermediate handlers that score in the top 30 percent of the end of year points in Nursery will move up as well as any Intermediate that makes it to final round of National Finals in Nursery will also be moved
 - Discussion occurred. It was decided to table the discussion.
