- Jimmy Walker moved that the National Cattledog Association National Nursery Finals include twenty-five (25) dogs qualified by earning points in NCA sanctioned trials and, in addition, one (1) dog from each NCA Regional Nursery Finals for each five (5) dogs in said finals, not to exceed two (2) dogs per final and that entries be limited to two (2) dogs per handler. The motion was seconded by Dan Gill and approved unanimously.
- Jimmy Walker moved that the National Cattledog Association National Intermediate Finals include, in addition to the previously approved twenty (20) dogs qualified by earning points in NCA sanctioned trials, one (1) dog from each NCA Regional Intermediate Finals for each five (5) dogs in said finals, not to exceed two (2) dogs per final and that entries be limited to two (2) dogs per handler. The motion was seconded by Dan Gill and approved unanimously.
- Dan Gill moved that all points earned by a dog count towards the Finals points ranking. The motion was seconded by Tim Gifford and approved unanimously.
